in 1974

Sedburgh, Garsdale  
and Dentdale  
Lost to Cumbria in  
1974

The Lost Lands...  
Stockton, Middlesbrough and Redcar  
Lost to Cleveland in 1974. Now  
unitary authority areas.

'Ceremonially' part of  
North Yorkshire

The Lost Lands...  
The East Riding  
Lost to Humberside  
in 1974. Recovered  
in 1996 and  
reinstated as the  
East Riding of  
Yorkshire

The Lost Lands...  
Bowland and  
Barnoldswick  
Lost to Lancashire  
in 1974

Todmorden  
Grew up on Lancashire  
side of River Calder but  
spilled over onto West  
Riding side and became  
split between two counties  
until 1888 when placed  
entirely in West Riding

The Lost Lands...  
Saddleworth  
'Returned' to Greater Manchester  
in 1974 (part of Rochdale in 1822)

The Lost Lands...  
Eastoft

Once split between the West Riding  
and Lincolnshire. Moved into Humberside in  
1974. Finally lost to Lincolnshire in 1996
